
Unity-Five Cities is putting together a Power of Eight Prayer Circle Program and there are some opportunities to participate. Here are the brief job descriptions:

- Coordinator to work with prayer venues, people who want to pray, people who want to receive prayer, group facilitators, and scheduling.
- Session Facilitator to communicate with prayer recipients and work with the Coordinator
- People Praying in Power of Eight circle will work with the Coordinator and Facilitator, and be present for the 10-minute prayer session either in-person or on Zoom
